GWAVA Vertigo was created to ease the burden of managing mailboxes by combining all of the functions into a single intuitive tool.

Proxy Management

Providing authorized access to an individual (who is not the owner) of a mailbox is important in a corporate setting. Vertigo allows complete control of proxy rights for single or multiple users. As job roles change, it is important to be able to easily add and remove users from the proxy access list and as well as control the rights those users have. Vertigo lets you set all proxy rights -- from complete access, to view only, to printing, or even exporting.

Rules Management

Rules are designed to streamline and automate repetitive tasks and to take action when user intervention is not possible. Vertigo lets administrators enable, disable and delete rules. Of course, all administrator changes are logged and can be printed or exported to ensure corporate policies are properly enforced.

Folder Management

A well-organized folder structure ensures that messages and attachments are readily accessible when needed. Vertigo lets administrators see folder hierarchies, copy folder structures for one or more users and report on the information. Vertigo's functionality helps keep unnecessary folders from cluttering up a user's inbox.

Junk

Junk Mail, Junk List Management and Signatures...

Legitimate email and attachments fill everyone's inboxes quickly enough without adding unwanted junk mail. Getting the information users need means it's important to keep the junk mail to a minimum, enforce corporate policies and set what email is going to the junk mail folder. With Vertigo, it's easy to change, delete or update signatures based on rules. Signatures can be pushed to one or more users.

Archive

Vertigo also allows expired accounts to be archived using the integration between Archive To Go and Vertigo (similar to Reveal 1.5).



Reporting

Because GroupWise is so customizable and offers a unique messaging experience for different users based on job roles or simple preferences, it is important to be able to track, manage and report on a single or multiple users. Reporting helps administrators restore mailboxes and enforce corporate policies when needed. Vertigo allows administrators to search and report on every available property of a GroupWise user (FID, visibility, department name, title, domain, post office, internet addressing, etc.).

System Requirements

- ▶ Vertigo runs on Windows 2000, Windows XP or Window Server 2003 Microsoft .NET
- ▶ Framework 2.0 or 3.0 should be installed. Installing all Security Updates for Microsoft .NET Framework through e.g. Windows. Update is highly recommended
- ▶ GroupWise 7 SP3 at minimum is required on the server (POA) and SP3 when using Rules related features. However, Support Pack 3 is strongly advised.
- ▶ GroupWise 7 SP3 Win32 client is required on the workstation
- ▶ SOAP/XML should be enabled on all of your GroupWise post offices, the use of SSL is optional and supported
